Dear B.O.T.A. Members, Families, and Friends,

You are cordially invited to join your B.O.T.A. brothers and sisters for a weekend of fellowship, fun, and inspiration at the beautiful Asilomar Conference Grounds in Pacific Grove on the Monterey Peninsula. The Annual West Coast B.O.T.A. Retreat is co-sponsored by the Northwest and Southern California / Arizona B.O.T.A. Regions. This year's theme is "Nothing Endures But Change."

The Asilomar Conference Grounds cover 109 acres dedicated to a natural ecological environment with historic buildings nestled among the trees and the coastal sand dunes. It is Asilomar Conference Grounds policy that all food and beverages be purchased from them. No food or beverages may be brought onto the grounds for group consumption.

The cost for the entire weekend, including Friday dinner through Sunday lunch and lodging, is \$296 per person. If you are able to pay in full by May 29<sup>th</sup>, the cost will be \$269. The minimum deposit is \$150. Should you choose to stay off-site, registration with meals is \$155 per person for the entire weekend. Off-site registration without meals is \$77 per person for the entire weekend or \$27 per person per day.

Saturday afternoon after lunch, there will be a Pronaos Ritual at the Pacific Grove Masonic Temple. Only B.O.T.A. members in good standing may attend. Members must bring proof of current membership (a lesson envelope or online dues payment receipt). Pronaos must present a valid Pronaos Membership Card to be admitted as Pronaos. All other B.O.T.A. members in good standing will be admitted as guests.

For those who do not wish to attend Pronaos on Saturday afternoon, the Monterey Peninsula is yours to explore and enjoy. The Monterey Bay Aquarium, 17 Mile Drive, Carmel-by-the-Sea, Point Lobos State Reserve, and Fisherman's Wharf are all nearby and the Pacific Ocean is just a lovely walk from the Asilomar grounds.

*Rooms are double occupancy (two occupants assigned to each room) and include 3 days / 2 nights lodging and meals (Friday dinner through Sunday lunch).*

Youths (age 3-17), per person .....\$154  
*No discount for early reservation – please provide your own child care*

Single room occupant.....\$450

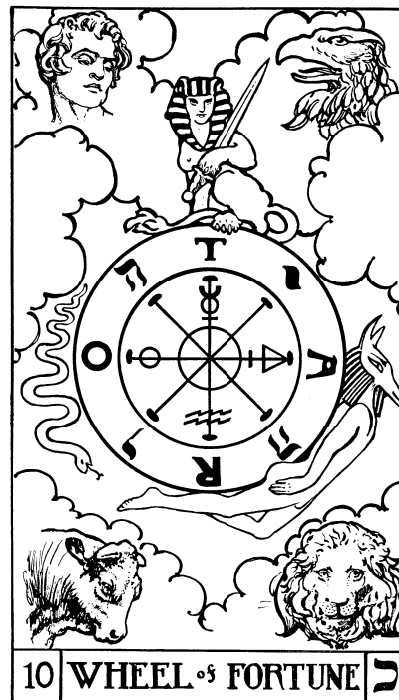
