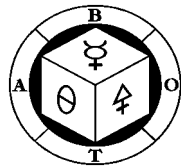

The YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly is located in the Black Mountain, North Carolina, 15 miles East of Asheville, N.C. The site offers 1200 acres of woodland, including mountain streams, wildflowers, ridges, valleys and spectacular views. Just two miles from Exit 64 on I-40, the Blue Ridge Assembly is easily accessible by car. Visitors flying to the area use the Asheville Regional Airport.
